

The Human Heart: Fact and Fiction

This year's LCC Reads author Claire Holden Rothman (The Heart Specialist) and Dr. Ariane Marelli (Director of the MAUDE Cardiology Unit at the Montreal General Hospital and LCC parent) spoke at the Middle and Senior School assembly on Tuesday, November 29. This event was the culmination of a year's planning by the LCC Reads Committee: thirty-five Middle and Senior School students, Miss Varvarikos, Ms. Borod, Ms. Mazzella and Mr. Moore. Ms. Rothman presented the inspirations for her novel, as well as for writing in general, and a brief history of Canadian and Quebec women pioneers in the field of medicine.
